The Levels of Consequences are based on:

- Severity of the offence.
- Disciplinary history of the student.
- Circumstances relating to the offence.

Level 1 (Warning): Written or verbal warning issued to the student detailing the incident.

Level 2 (Detention): Academic or Community Service Detention will be issued.

Level 3 (Parent Conference): Dean will request a meeting with parents, students and teachers to discuss the incident.

Level 4 (Behaviour Contract): Contract to be signed by both parents and student outlining the expected behaviour of the student and consequences if the contract is broken.

Level 5 (Suspension): Internal or External Suspension can be issued.

Level 6 (Extended Suspension): The Principal can request an Extended Suspension.

Level 7 (MOE Case Conference): Officials from the MOE can request a Case Conference to discuss the incident.

Level 8 (Expulsion): The MOE can recommend the Expulsion of a student.
